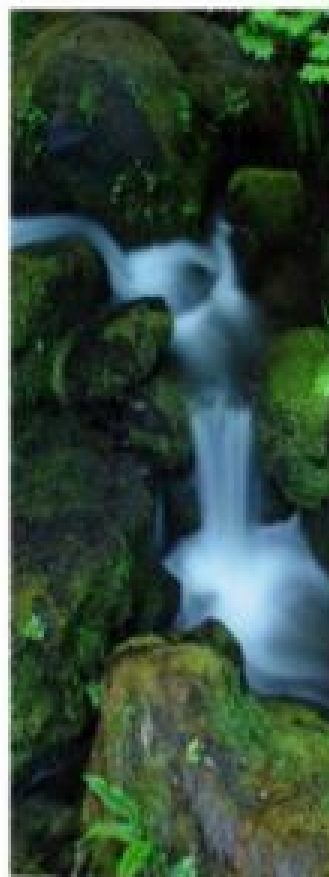
Recycling in Fayetteville:
