Civil Right Ordinance Please Vote For On Sept 8th

The Ordinance: The "Ordinance to Ensure Uniform Nondiscrimination Protections with the City of Fayetteville for Groups Already Protected to Varying Degrees Throughout State Law" is a compromise piece of legislation created



through input from people who live and work in Fayetteville. Ordinance 5781 adds language to existing legislation that provides greater protections for gays, lesbians and transgender individuals, as well as other groups commonly discriminated against. In addition, this ordinance creates a pathway to bring complaints to the city when citizens feel discrimination has occurred..
