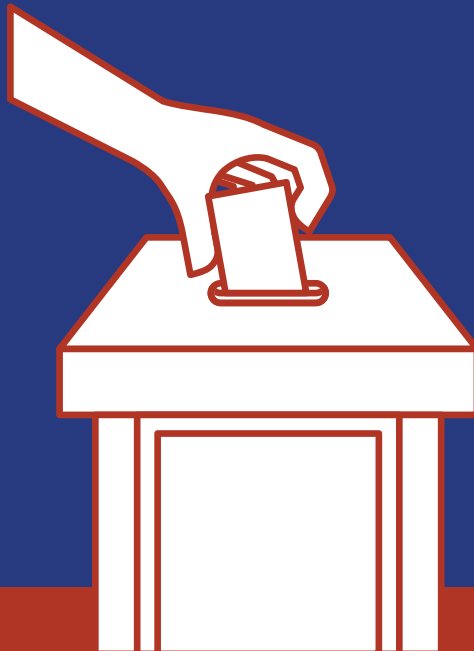

REGISTER TO VOTE

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REGISTER TO VOTE

You must register to vote at least 30 days before the election. The last day to register for 2020 election is: October 5, 2020.



TO REGISTER YOU MUST:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be an Arkansas resident (residing here at least 30 days before the election.)
- Be 18 or turn 18 before the next election
- Not be convicted of a felony (unless your sentence has been discharged or pardoned)
- Not be presently adjudged mentally incompetent as to your ability to vote by a court of competent jurisdiction
- Not claim the right to vote in any other county or state

All forms must be returned to the County Clerk Office by mail or in person. Anyone can turn them in. Arkansas does not offer online voter registration.

You will know you are registered to vote when and only when you receive an acknowledgement from your county clerk. You can check the status of your registration after two weeks by calling 479-444-1711 or by going to <https://www.voterview.ar-nova.org/VoterView>

Early Voting is October 19- November 2. Call the County Clerk's office 479-444-1711 or the Election Commission, 479-444-1766 for hours and locations.

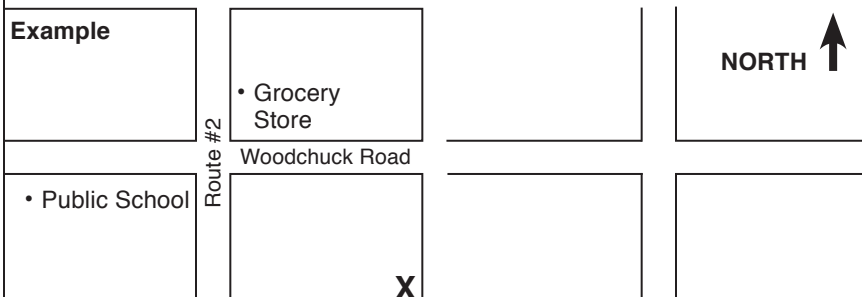

IMPORTANT: Applicants will be required to verify their registration when voting in person or by absentee ballot by providing a required document or identification card as provided in Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 51, Section 13. If your voter registration application form is submitted by mail and you are registering for the first time, and you do not have a valid Arkansas driver's license number or social security number, in order to avoid the additional identification requirements upon voting for the first time you must submit with the mailed registration form: (a) a current and valid photo identification; or (b) a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address.

Deadline Information

To qualify to vote in the next election, you must apply to register to vote 30 days before the election. If you mail this form, it must be postmarked by that date. You may also present it to a voter registration agency representative by that date. If you miss the deadline you will not be registered in time to vote in that election. *Please don't delay. Make sure your vote counts.*

If you are qualified and the information on your form is complete, you will be notified of your voting precinct by your local County Clerk.

A bearer, administrator, or agent must provide a current and valid photo ID to the clerk and must sign the register, under oath, when picking up or delivering an absentee ballot.

The information I have provided is true to the best of my knowledge under penalty of perjury. If I have provided false information, I may be subject to a fine of up to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or imprisonment for up to ten (10) years, or both under federal laws.

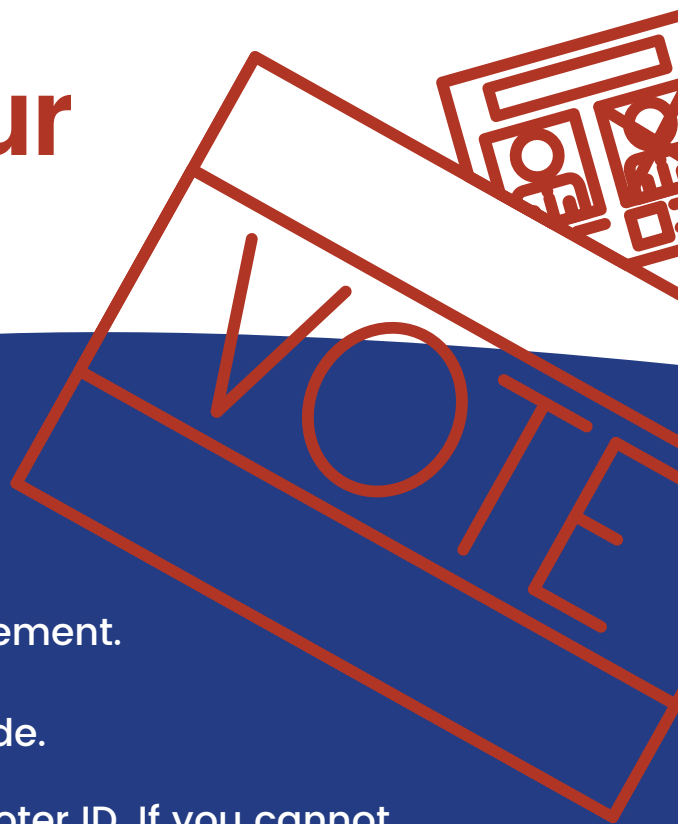

Completing Your Absentee Ballot



- ✓ Follow the voting instructions.
- ✓ Be sure to complete the Voter Statement.
- ✓ PRINT all the information you provide.
- ✓ Include a copy of your Approved Voter ID. If you cannot, you may sign the Optional Verification Identity Affirmation in the Voter Statement.
- ✓ Sign your name.
- ✓ Place your marked ballot in the inner ballot secrecy mailing envelope provided.
- ✓ Place your inner ballot envelope in the outer mailing envelope provided.
- ✓ Stamp your envelope (may require more than 1 stamp, depending on the weight of the ballot). The stamp requirement will be posted once the ballots are ready for mailing, check here: www.votewashingtonco.com
- ✓ If returned by mail, your ballot must be postmarked 7 days before Election Day and received by Election Day. If hand-delivered by the voter, it must be received by close of business on November 2, 2020. (Do not fax or email.)
- ✓ Return your ballot by mail (Recommended by October 19, 2020) or drop off early to make sure it gets counted.

 - (f) A student ID card issued by a postsecondary educational institution located in Arkansas;
 - (g) A United States Military or Veterans Affairs ID identification document;
 - (h) A public assistance identification card containing a photo of the person to whom the card was issued;
 - (i) A voter identification card as provided under Act 633 of 2017 and rules promulgated by the Secretary of State
3. The Ballot Only Envelope containing my marked ballot

First Time Voters Only
First-time voters who registered to vote by mail and did not provide identification when they registered also have a statutory requirement to provide identification.

If you are a first-time voter who registered to vote by mail and did not provide identification when registering, please include one of the following:

A copy of a current and valid photo identification OR a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows name and address.

*A person who resides in a long-term care or residential care facility licensed by the state may instead provide documentation from the administrator of the facility attesting that the person is a resident of the facility. Contact the County Clerk for a standardized form.

CHECK LIST FOR ENSURING YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT COUNTS

Make sure you completed the following steps to ensure your absentee ballot counts:

1. COMPLETE VOTER STATEMENT

- In Box 2, did you print your **Name**?
- In Box 3, did you print your **Date of Birth**?
- In Box 4, did you print your last valid **Address** in Washington County, AR?
- In Box 5, did you **Sign** your name?
- Did you include a copy of **Approved Photo ID**:
See # 2 on Voter Statement?
- If you were unable to provide a copy of Approved Photo ID, did you sign Box 1? **This does not apply to First Time Voters. See Box to right.*
- Place your completed Voter Statement in the outer mailing envelope provided.

***First Time Voters Only**

If you are a first-time voter who registered to vote by mail and did not provide identification when registering, please include one of the following:

A copy of a current and valid photo identification OR a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows name and address.

Failure to provide ID may result in your Absentee Ballot not counting.

2. VOTE YOUR BALLOT

- Follow voting instructions on Ballot.
- Place your marked ballot in the inner ballot secrecy envelope provided.
- Place your sealed ballot secrecy envelope in the outer mailing envelope provided.

3. RETURN YOUR BALLOT TO THE COUNTY CLERK BY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING METHODS:

- By Mail: Ballot must be received in the office of the County Clerk no later than 7:30 p.m. on Election Day
- Return by a Third Party (Designated Bearer): Ensure the person whose information is recorded in Box 6 on the Voter Statement returns ballot directly to the County Clerk's Office.
- Hand Delivered by Voter: Return ballot to the County Clerk's office by close of business on the day before the Election.

SPECIAL NOTES FOR CIVILIANS OVERSEAS

DEADLINE TO RETURN YOUR BALLOT BY MAIL:

- If you applied more than 30 days prior to the Election your ballot must be received in the office of the County Clerk no later than 10 days after the date of the Election.
- If you applied less than 30 days prior to the Election, your ballot must be received in the office of the County Clerk no later than 7:30 p.m. on Election Day

SPECIAL NOTES FOR ACTIVE DUTY ARMED SERVICES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS

ID: Active duty members or Spouses/ Dependents of a uniformed service, the Arkansas National Guard, a merchant mariner who are absent due to service you are not required to return a copy of your photo ID

DEADLINE TO RETURN YOUR BALLOT: Your ballot must be received in the office of the County Clerk no later than 10 days after the date of the Election.
